



Our Intensive Hospitality English Language Program (IHELP) focuses on intensive English learning while also teaching students important hospitality industry communication skills and knowledge.





Students can undertake the IHELP 6 in Switzerland and, on fulfilling the BBA or MSc entrance requirements, continue their studies in Switzerland or in London. If an applicant completes IHELP 6 in Switzerland and achieves the English level required to study in the United Kingdom they can transfer in Semester 3 for the Bachelor's program or in Semester 1 for the MSc programs.

# How it works

## IHELP 6 for Bachelor candidates

**DESIGNED FOR STUDENTS WHO HAVE MIN. IELTS 5.0 OVERALL (MIN. 4.5 IN EVERY SUBCOMPONENT) ON APPLICATION**

Bachelor applicants in the IHELP 6 must achieve a minimum test score equivalent to a high B2 level on the Common European Framework of Reference to progress onto the 3.5 year Bachelor's program at Glion Institute of Higher Education in Switzerland. This test takes place on site at the beginning and end of the IHELP 6. For London, non-EU or EEA passport holders will need to undertake IELTS UKVI: 5.5 overall (min. 5.5 in every subcomponent).

Students who have IELTS 4.5 overall (min. 4.0 in any subcomponent) can opt for our four-year Bachelor program with immersive English language study.

## IHELP 6 for MSc candidates

**DESIGNED FOR STUDENTS WHO HAVE MIN. IELTS 5.5 OVERALL (MIN. 5.0 IN EVERY SUBCOMPONENT) ON APPLICATION**

MSc applicants in the IHELP 6 must achieve a minimum test score equivalent to a high B2/C1 level on the Common European Framework of Reference, in order to progress onto the MSc programs at Glion Institute of Higher Education in Switzerland. This test takes place on site at the beginning and end of the IHELP 6. For London, non-EU or EEA passport holders will need to undertake IELTS UKVI: 6.0 overall (min. 5.5 in every subcomponent).


## Program learning outcomes

# Program entry requirements

## **IHELP 6 FOR BACHELOR CANDIDATES**

Must be 17 years and 3 months old or above.

English level: IELTS 5.0 overall (min. 4.5 in every subcomponent) on application.

## **IHELP 6 FOR MASTER'S CANDIDATES**

Must be 21 years old or above.

English level: min. IELTS 5.5 overall (min. 5.0 in every subcomponent) on application.

## **ALL IHELP 6 CANDIDATES**

Equivalent English certificates such as Cambridge and TOEFL are accepted on application and all English certificates must have been issued in the 12 months prior to admission.

Must hold a valid passport. Nationals of any country can apply and follow the required process for obtaining a visa.

## How to apply

Complete the CH or UK application form and select the IHELP program required.

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Provide a copy of your IELTS English language level certificate or equivalent.

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Arrange payment of the program fees.

Please note: in case of cancellation, we will refund the total amount of the program if the cancellation is made 14 days or more prior to the start of the program in writing to the Admissions Department. 50% of the full amount will be refunded if cancellation occurs up to 14 days before the start of the program. No refund will apply if the student does not attend or start on the first day of the course without cancelling beforehand.

### Program fees include

Please note that all items below are included in the program fees as stipulated. If some items are not used, then no reduction of fees will be applied.

- Tuition fees, learning resources and Hospitality Experiential Immersion activities
- Prepaid Food and Beverage Account (based on consumption)
- Lodging in double superior room – en-suite bathroom
- Health insurance
- Airport pick-up from Geneva Airport on official arrival days

### Program fees do not include

- Pocket money, laundry costs, visa fees, airport transfers in home country and flights.
- Exam fees for the Academic English test at the beginning and end of the IHELP 6.

### Accommodation

Subject to availability, students can select a single room for an additional fee. The prices below are in Swiss Francs, per person, for the duration of one semester, and in addition to the double superior room with en-suite bathroom fee:
